Both should declare that:

- they are not a relative, solicitor or agent of the applicant;
- they are not related to the other referee;
- they are not employed by the Home Office;
- they have not been convicted of an imprisonable offence during the last 10 years (unless conviction has become spent under the Rehabilitation of Offenders Act 1974);
- they have known the applicant personally for more than 3 years;
- they are willing to give full details of their knowledge of the applicant;
- they will advise the Home Office of any reason why the applicant should not be registered.

Name of applicant

One referee should be a person of any nationality who has professional standing, e.g. Minister of religion, civil servant, or a member of a professional body e.g. accountant or solicitor (who is not representing you with this application).

The other referee must be a holder of a British citizen passport and either a professional person or over the age of 25.

The referees must not be related to each other.



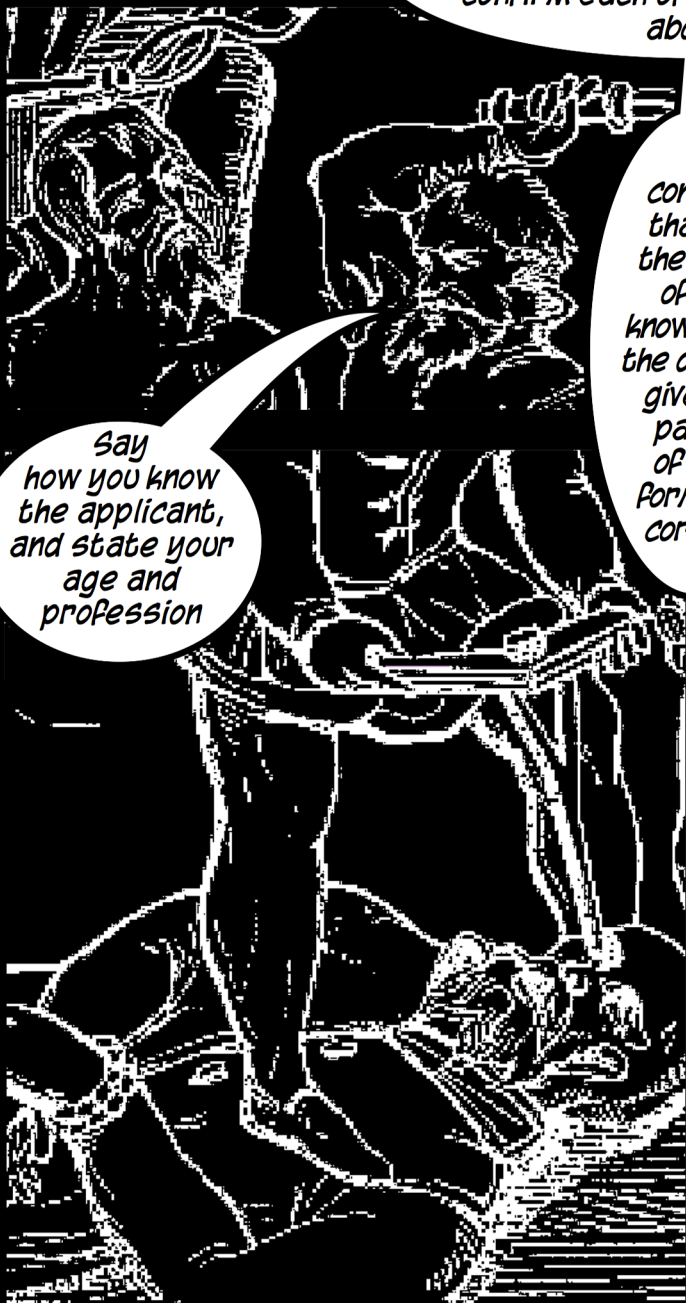
